STUDENTS

SCHOOL IS BACK IN SESSION: That means that we all need to follow the dress code policy that is printed in your Student Handbook regardless of the weather conditions. If you are not in compliance, the following actions will be taken as follows:

- a. Bring you to the office to change the clothes that do not follow the dress code and/or a phone call to your parent to notify him/her that you are not following the dress code and to bring you the appropriate clothing from home.
- b. If you borrow school clothing to change, you are to return it at the end of the day, if you do not, you will have a disciplinary consequence/monetary obligation.

DRESS CODE

The following guidelines shall apply to all regular school activities, including dances:

- **1.** Shoes must be worn at all times.
- 2. Clothing, accessories and personal items (including backpacks and binders) shall be free of inappropriate writing, pictures or any other insignia that makes references to drugs, sex, alcohol, tobacco products, violence, weapons, vulgarity, nudity, racial supremacy or other anti-social behavior.
- **3.** Hats, caps and other head coverings, including scarves and headbands, shall not be worn inside the classroom. Also, gloves are not to be worn.
- **4.** Clothes shall be sufficient to conceal undergarments at all times. See-through or fishnet fabrics, halter tops, off-the-shoulder or low-cut tops, bare midriffs and skirts or shorts shorter than mid-thigh are prohibited.
- **5.** Gym shorts may not be worn in classes other than physical education.
- 6. Hair shall be clean and neatly groomed. Hair may not be sprayed with any coloring that would drip when wet.
- **7.** NO sagging pants or underwear showing. Pants will be worn at waist.
