

- VUSD testing allows VUSD staff to reach out to students or staff members who test positive. If one tests positive from VUSD testing, then a health staff member will be in contact to discuss your status.
- A PCR test taken at a non VUSD location is NOT reported to VUSD, therefore please ensure the following if a positive result is recei
 - Do not attend school
 - Notify health services at 805.641.5116 x 1028
