May 20 - June 3

*Please make sure to review student attendance and recover unexcused absences as appropriate.

UNEXCUSED TARDIES/ABSENCES:

Daily automated calls for tardies and absences.
Students will be obligated to attend detention and/or Saturday school to attend school dances/senior activities/field trips if they have excessive unexcused absences or tardies.

Saturday schools will be assigned and notifications to families will be sent.

Detention will be student initiated in fulfilling their obligations prior to upcoming school events (dances, senior activities and field trips).

DETENTION/SATURDAY SCHOOL CRITERIA:

After 6 tardies students will serve detention for any tardy thereafter or an obligation will be noted.

After 9 unexcused class absences, a student will need to serve a Saturday School to clear them.

DETENTION CLEARS 2 TARDIES.

SATURDAY SCHOOL CLEARS 3 UNEXCUSED PERIOD ABSENCES OR 1 FULL UNEXCUSED DAY ABSENCE.

ABSENCES MUST BE CLEARED WITHIN 5 DAYS OF THE OCCURRENCE AS STATED ON THE VUSD ATTENDANCE HANDBOOK.
