Volunteer Opportunity: California Coastal Cleanup Day 2019 is Saturday, September 21st, from 9 am to 12 noon. Go to www.coastal.ca.gov to find clean-up sites. Waiver of liability forms available in the College & Career Center.

AP exam registration this year is due by OCTOBER 25, 2019. AP exams will be May 4 - 15, 2020.

You must complete three steps to register.

Step 1: Go online and join the AP Classroom for each subject you want to take the AP exam. Get the join code from your AP teacher. You must be on the AP Classroom online roster in order to have an exam ordered for you.

Step 2: Pay for your exams at the student store. You may pay online via the Web Store on the VHS website

https://www.venturausd.org/ventura/home (New this year - you may make a 50% deposit to reserve your exam and make payments for AP exams.)

Step 3: Turn in your completed AP exam registration form with your receipt of payment attached to Ms. Adamich in the library by October 25, 2019.

*AP Exam registrations turned in AFTER OCTOBER 25 will have a \$40 late fee added.
