October is National Anti-bullying month. As part of your daily bulletin for this month, you will be given a new statistic with each bulletin. Please use these statistics to have a conversation with your friends/classmates/teachers/family/community on how you —and they- can be part of the solution against bullying behavior. Here's today's statistic:

A meta-analysis of 80 studies analyzing bullying involvement rates (for both bullying others and being bullied) for 12-18 year old students reported a mean prevalence rate of 35% for traditional bullying involvement and 15% for cyberbullying involvement (Modecki, Minchin, Harbaugh, Guerra, & Runions, 2014).
