Art with Heart for those dealing with anxiety, art can ignite healing powers; turning pain into possibility through drawing/coloring in personal sketch books; empowering students to work through their feelings, build resilience and see a future full of possibility via creative expression.

Stress Management designed to help students with the stress they may be feeling about the Coronavirus; bring safety and balance to the body; calming the brain to bring normalcy on the inside regardless of what is going on, on the outside; help students to identify stress and its physical and emotional symptoms, how to identify stressful situations that are within/without our control and ways to manage stress through relaxation and deep breathing techniques.
