

- Parking will be in lower student lot only.
- No entry after 9 P.M.
- For the safety and security of our students at the Homecoming dance, the following protocols will be instituted:
- No large bags (backpacks) will be allowed.
- All student belongings will be screened.
- Random breathalyzer checks will be conducted.
- No liquids (water bottles, perfumes, etc.) of any type will be allowed. A water station will be available.
- No re-entry upon exiting the dance.



DETENTIONS AND SATURDAY SCHOOL NOTIFICATIONS

Students & Parents please review your attendance and recover tardies and unexcused absences through lunch detention or Saturday school.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

UNEXCUSED TARDIES/ABSENCES:

Daily automated calls for tardies and absences. Students will be obligated to attend detention and/or Saturday school to attend school dances/senior activities/field trips if they have excessive unexcused absences or tardies.

Saturday schools will be assigned and notifications to families will be sent.

Detention will be student initiated in fulfilling their obligations prior to upcoming school events (dances, senior activities and field trips).

DETENTION/SATURDAY SCHOOL CRITERIA: After 6 tardies students will serve detention for any tardy thereafter or an obligation will be noted.

3 unexcused period absences (more than 30 minutes late) Full day unexcused absence

DETENTION CLEARS 2 TARDIES.

SATURDAY SCHOOL ATTENDANCE CLEARS UNEXCUSED PERIOD ABSENCES AND UNEXCUSED DAY ABSENCES.

*** If more accumulated, additional detentions/Saturday Schools will need to be served.***

Gap Periods: Students w a Period 1/2 gap may arrive at start of Period 3 or 4. If arriving prior to class time, library or quad are designated areas.
