Pacific High School's goal is to re-engage all students in their high school learning experiences, while providing students with the knowledge, skills, and mindset to be successful in their future college or career pathways.





PROJECT-BASED LEARNING

- Students engage in an interdisciplinary semester long project
- Students apply academic content to the real-world while learning 21st century skills critical thinking, collaboration, communication, and creativity/innovation.



CREDIT RECOVERY

- 17.5 Credits available to earn in 6 school periods (2.5 more than traditional).
- No Homework in Periods 1-6 unless students are absent. Daily Homework is Edgenuity Credit Recovery Units. Students take 1-2 online classes in Edgenuity in addition to Periods 1-5 or 1-6.
- Pacific High School concurrently enrolls students at Ventura College, and Ventura Adult and Continuing Education (VACE).



YOUTH ACTIVITIES - AFTER SCHOOL

- Students can participate daily in before-school activities (7:15am 8:05am) and afterschool activites (12:42pm to 3:00pm).
- Arts & Crafts, Weight Training, Photography, Cooking, Graphic Design, Billiards/Ping Pong, Gaming, Credit Recovery, Club meetings and Fieldtrips



SUPPORT

- Full Time counselor, 20:1 ratio of students to teachers, 3 campus supervisors, and 3 administrators create a safe and supportive learning environment.
- Student support groups include Drug & Alcohol, Teen Parent, Grief, LGBTQ+, Homeroom Social Emotional Learning and weekly Circles.

Top 10 for Pacific families...

- Students should always have Credit Recovery Units to complete in Edgenuity. (homework)
- Students should seek out extended learning opportunities (i.e. CTE, Adult Education, Ventura College, Afterschool programs, 6th period when available)
- 3) Students should earn at least 15 credits each quarter; but more if credit deficient.
- 4) Get to know your student's homeroom teacher & counselor.
- Auditorium opens at 7:15am and breakfast is served early to accommodate families.
- 6) All students benefit from participation in afterschool Youth Activities from 12:42pm to 3:00pm.
- 7) Students can earn up to 3 elective credits per quarter by participating in Youth Activities Enrichment.
- 8) Core academic program: 8:10am to 12:42pm; 6th period addition to 1:45pm
- 9) Check your child's "Graduation Progress Sheet" (GPS) each quarter to see if they're on track to graduate.
- 10) Seniors and 18 year old students need to maintain 15 credits/quarter, 90% attendance, and demonstrate exemplary behavior.
