



Pacific High School Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: Is the Pacific High School Diploma a regular high school diploma?

A: Yes. Students who graduate from PHS are eligible to go directly to a Community College, Career Technical School, and into the military.

Q: Can my student meet the A-G requirements or take A.P. Classes at Pacific High School?

A: PHS can offer some of these higher-level courses via Edgenuity on-line but does not offer these honors courses in the regular schedule. If this is a priority for your student then the other VUSD high schools would be a better fit.

Q: Can I return to my home high school to graduate?

A: Yes you can, IF you are caught up in credits OR if you were a voluntary transfer with no behavior/suspension terms.

Q: Can my part-time job count as elective credits at PHS?

A: Yes. Students can earn Work Experience Elective credits when they turn in the paperwork required every quarter.

Q: Does PHS have an athletics program?

A: PHS does not have formal CIF athletic offerings; only intramurals are offered in the after school program. Participation in after school activities earns elective credits.

Q: Does PHS offer student clubs or ASB?

A: Yes PHS has a strong ASB program and many clubs and activities sponsored by the after-school program. Participation in the after school activities earns elective credits.

Q: How do I enroll at PHS?

A: Step 1: Call PHS to discuss the available openings and schedule a tour

Step 2: Contact your home school counselor/administrator to request placement

Step 3: Placement committee reviews request and accepts/rejects placement
