Cheers for Children



Recycling at Pierpont

We are excited to announce that the students at Pierpont Elementary School are now recycling, sorting, and composting their lunch trash to reduce the waste created at Pierpont. In partnership with the City of Ventura, Pierpont Elementary has joined many other VUSD elementary schools in reducing our waste through joining the Healthy and Green Schools Partnership.

The Healthy and Greens Schools Partnership is a group of Ventura Unified School District faculty, staff and students who collaborate with community organizations to promote sustainable solutions to the management of VUSD's resources and increase environmental awareness among the student body and staff. Through the educational outreach component of the program, all grade levels received in-class education from environmental experts. At Pierpont Elementary, the educational outreach component of the program occurred in November.

Our program requires students to drain milk cartons, recycle any recyclables, compost any food products, dispose of anything that needs to be taken to a landfill, and finally stack their cardboard trays. Through sorting their own waste, Pierpont Elementary School students are significantly reducing the amount of trash that we are sending to a landfill.
