Attendance & Vacations

Last year Pierpont's attendance slightly increased to 96.6% and this year we are hoping to reach our annual goal of 98% attendance. There are approximately 180 instructional days per year and it is important that all students attend each day that they are healthy and able. Plan trips and appointments outside of school hours so that students do not miss valuable instruction. Please do not sign your child out early unless it is necessary, as interruptions are disruptive and students miss valuable instruction.

Absences without calls and absences due to vacations are considered truancies. Absences for medical appointments, or illness of 3 days or more, will require a note from a doctor to be considered excused. Students who are ill, or who have had a fever in the last 24 hours, should stay home from school. To help in your planning of vacations and appointments, please visit our school web-site where you can find a calendar with holi-

days and school schedules. If your child is absent due to illness, or any other reason, please be sure to call in the absence. For any absence, students are strongly encouraged to attend our Saturday Attendance Academies, where students participate in engaging, extra-curricular instructional projects. Saturday Academies also help students earn perfect attendance. Please help us provide the best education possible and reach our goal of 98% attendance.
