

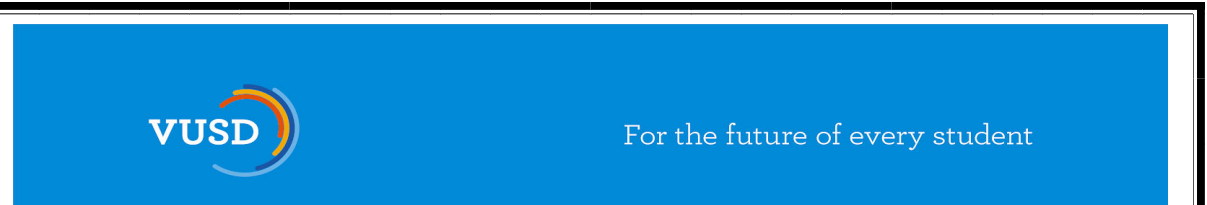
SCHOOL-LAW PARTNERSHIP
