#### EDUCATION:

All students at Sunset will receive explicit training and lessons about anti– bullying, handling peer conflicts, how to report peer concerns and how to treat all humans with kindness and respect both virtually and when on campus! Classroom teachers, our counselor Ms. Agnes and principal Sims will all be presenting lessons to students. These grade-level geared teachings will include social emotional "check ins" so that we can best support our Sunset School students.

#### SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING AND SCHOOL-WIDE LANGUAGE:

Explicitly teaching how to manage your emotions is essential to personal and academic growth as well. You will hear about these things at home; "BUCKET FILLING VRS. BUCKET DIPPING" and "BEING AN UPSTANDER NOT A BYSTANDER", "ZONES OF REGULATION", "BIG DEALS VS. LITTLE DEALS" and various self-control strategies. All of these tools will be taught and reinforced. When we all use the same language the expectations for all students are clear!

#### CULTURE:


