FOR YOUR SAFETY, REMINDER: *There has been an increase in vehicle, pedestrian, and bicyclist traffic accidents on E. Main St., between MacMillian Ave. to Seaward Ave. near Ventura High School. As a reminder, please adhere to the following for crossing all the areas near Ventura High School.*

- *All students crossing at an intersection need to wait for the green “WALK” signal prior to crossing. Do not start walking across the street against a red “DON’T WALK” signal. While crossing a street, do not walk between vehicles while they are stopped at an intersection.*
- *All students crossing need to walk in the designated marked cross walks ONLY. Students riding their bicycles to and from school need to ride on the right side of the roadway, with the flow of traffic. This reminder is for your safety and awareness.
